

Ministry initiatives

Church ministry

Church move



During the first half of the year, the focus was to move the church from the basement to a main level building. Many options were evaluated and finally we decided to move to the current location of 1-1264 St. Margarets Bay Rd. We started the Sunday service in the new place on the 16th of June. The new building was officially inaugurated on the 22nd of June during the regular third Saturday service.

Baptism service

Baptism was conducted during the family retreat in Camp Evangeline, Truro, NS. The church congregation and the family members of those individuals who took baptism went on a procession to the baptism location singing choruses. Prasanth Mukundan, Kishan Garapati and Hagen Goldwin were given baptism by immersion in the name of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit in the stream that flows through Camp Evangeline.



Multilingual service



There is nothing like worshipping the Lord in our mother tongue. On every second Sunday evening at 6.30 we have been worshipping the Lord by singing songs in different languages and sharing the word in English. Some of the languages we sing with are Tamil, Malayalam, Telugu, Hindi, and Tagalog. Each of these songs is transliterated in English so that the congregation can participate in singing. We found this service being one of the very effective tools that bring unity among people of different nationalities and tongues.

Small groups



Three small groups have been initiated during 2013. These small groups focus on the individuals and families living in different parts of the city who would like to get connected with the church. It is also an effort to invite non-Christians and those who are not having a home church and encourage them to be part of our ministry. These three small groups are located in Halifax south end, Halifax north end and in Clayton Park.

Gospel meetings

Gospel meetings are conducted on the third Saturday of each month. Many friends and families were introduced to the ministry through Gospel meetings. Children’s performance has been the highlight of the Gospel meeting. Children practice on every Saturday and perform on the third Saturday. Every Gospel meeting has been a spiritually nourishing experience through the Word. The potluck at the end of the service has been an effective time to have fellowship with one another.

Fasting prayers

Fasting and praying is the most powerful means of attacking the strong holds of the enemy. We have experienced the power of fasting during these days.

- June 1 to 21 - 21 days fasting prayer
- August 15th – Prayer for India
- September 11th – Prayer for America
- November 12th – Prayer for Canada
- December 1 to 21 - 21 days fasting Prayer
- Every Tuesday for the children & every Friday for the countries
- Saturday fasting prayer – every 2nd and 4th Saturday

Women’s prayer

Women gather together for a time of prayer at the church on every Thursday at 7.30pm. It has been a powerful time of intercession by the HIPM women. Many miracles have been witnessed and deliverances have been experienced as a result of this prayer. We believe that this prayer will eventually grow and the fire is going to catch the entire church, the community and the city.

Children ministry

Children are part of every service in HIPM. We believe there is no reason why God can’t use children in the ministry. We care for them and take special efforts helping them to build a strong foundation in Christ Jesus. The following are some of the initiatives taken during 2013.

Sunday school

Every Sunday children are encouraged to come and stand in front of the congregation to sing a song or recite scriptures they memorized. At the time of preaching children are asked to join the Sunday school. Each child gets personal attention during this time and the children are encouraged to put into practice the scriptural truths they learn.

Children conference

Children conference takes place every Thursday evening by children dialing into a conference bridge. A mini version of the church service is conducted by children during the conference. Children involve themselves into various activities such as singing, praying, worshipping, Bible reading, sharing the Word, etc. as scheduled. They also share testimonies and pray for each other. There are 45 children participate in this conference. On a given day, more than 20 children connect to the conference. There are 12 new participants got added to the children conference in 2013.

Vacation Bible School (VBS)



VBS was conducted at the church from July 22nd until Aug 2nd for 10 days. The theme for VBS 2013 was “It’s your choice”. Around 18 kids participated in the VBS. Ruth Prasanth purchased VBS lessons and materials from India and donated to HIPM. Scripture was taught to the children by dividing them into four groups according to their age. Each group had dedicated teachers who prepared everyday lessons and taught them.

Outreach ministry

Few outreach activities the church has involved during this year are running an Alpha program at the church, visiting Oxford manor for conducting a service every month and celebrating Christmas at the community.

Alpha



The 10 week version of Alpha with Nicky Gumbel was run for 10 consecutive weeks with a weekend away program. Evan Kennedy coordinated the Alpha program at HIPM with the support of the Halifax Alpha coach Sherry Redden who was available to run an orientation session with the Alpha hosts/hostesses. There were more than 10 individuals participated in all sessions. Most of the participants were either non-Christians or unsaved. Weekend away session was conducted on Nov 2nd in the Bayside camp at Sambro Head, NS.

Oxford

God opened up an opportunity to minister to the residents of Oxford Manor once in a month through Joy Sison, the administrator. Meeting the spiritual needs of these residents is of priority as most of them might not have the opportunity to participate a regular church service. A Christmas carol service was conducted where more than 50 people participated including the families of the residents.



Christmas celebration



HIPM celebrated Christmas along with families and community friends on Dec 21 in the Lakeside Community Centre. More than 75 people participated in this event as the message of the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ was displayed through various children and adult performances. The highlight of the event was the Nativity play by HIPM kids and Sparkles day care Kids.

Bible teaching ministry

Teaching God's Word in an unadulterated manner was one of the mandates God has given to this ministry. Sermons and Bible studies are the effective methods of teaching God's Word in HIPM.

Bible study


A greater emphasis has been given to study the Bible systematically. Regular Bible Studies were conducted at the church on every Tuesday to study God's Word. The following are the major study topics of 2013.

Men's Bible study

The HIPM Men's Bible study has been a great blessing for the whole year of 2013. Every Monday evenings, from 9:00 PM to 10:00 PM, around 7 to 10 Men living in North America (USA and Canada), attend the Bible study on a regular basis. God has answered many prayers, and powerful testimonies being shared for the Glory of God. Each member gets the opportunity to share the word once in 2 months, and it has been an enriching experience for the Men to step-up and take part in the Ministry. Bro.Chandravel took a series on the Tabernacle and did a wonderful comparison of the Tabernacle of the Old Testament and the Spiritual tabernacle. Bro.David, Bro.Charwin and Bro.Christo, always bring prophetic messages from the Word that brings spiritual nourishment and encouragement. The worship led by Dahn and Joel, brings the presence of God and set the stage for the testimony time and the Bible study. We have a new member Bro.Kiran from the US and few other new members joined the team in this past year.

Women Bible reading



HIPM women came out with a Bible reading program that motivated women to read a portion of the scripture, discuss among them and also to share the highlights of their reading to the congregation on every Sunday. Online quizzes were conducted to motivate and to evaluate the reading exercise. This program was initiated and has been effectively maintained by Ruth Prasanth. The reading exercise will resume in the New Year starting from I Chronicles.

Mission initiatives

Unfortunately due to the move and the increased focus on local evangelism, couldn't achieve much on the mission front. HIPM helped empowering the pastors of our partner ministry Jesus My Shepherd International Ministries (JMSIM) by having few sessions with them. Representing HIPM, Prasanth & Ruth visited JMSIM, India and encouraged the pastors and their families during Christmas. Also Bibles and gifts were distributed to around 500 children living in the villages where JMSIM newly planted churches.



Student's ministry



Student ministry was started in October 2012 and continued during 2013. Initially we met at the multi-faith Center till May 2013 and continued meeting at the Subway and in Killam Library on every Wednesday. Some of the topics discussed so far include sin, consequences of sin and some of the specific sins. Kishan Garapati and David Raju took this initiative forward along with some believers of the church and with the university students. A need of winter clothing for the Asian students was identified and a Winter Clothing Giveaway was organized by Kishan Garapati and Grace Rajaretnam along with the help of the Salvation Army on Wednesday, Nov 27th.

Association with the PAOC

Our association with the PAOC has been a tremendous support to our ministry. We thank the Maritime District Superintendent Rev. Kevin Johnson and his family for visiting and ministering to us. I can't forget to thank the HRM PAOC pastors for their tremendous support and especially the Mosaic Ministries for hosting the pastor's breakfast and opening up an opportunity to interact with the other pastors.
