Who is Holy Spirit

In Creation

- **Genesis 1:2** The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the **Spirit of God** was hovering over the face of the waters.
- **Psalms 104:30** You send forth **Your Spirit**, they are created; And You renew the face of the earth.
- **Genesis 2:7** And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils **the breath of life**; and man became a living being.
- **Genesis 1:26** Then God said, “Let Us make man in **Our image**, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.”
- **Genesis 1:27** So **God created man in His own image**; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.
- **Job 33:4** The **Spirit of God has made me**, And the breath of the Almighty gives me life.

Who is Holy Spirit

Came upon the prophets, Kings and Priests of OT

- **2 Samuel 23:2** “The Spirit of the LORD spoke by me, And His word was on my tongue.
- **Numbers 24:2** And Balaam raised his eyes, and saw Israel encamped according to their tribes; and **the Spirit of God came upon him.**
- **1 Samuel 10:10** When they came there to the hill, there was a group of prophets to meet him; then **the Spirit of God came upon him**, and he prophesied among them.
- **1 Samuel 11:6** Then **the Spirit of God came upon Saul** when he heard this news, and his anger was greatly aroused.
- **1 Samuel 19:20** Then Saul sent messengers to take David. And when they saw the group of prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing as leader over them, **the Spirit of God came upon the messengers of Saul**, and they also prophesied.
- **2 Chronicles 15:1** Now **the Spirit of God came upon Azariah** the son of Oded.
- **2 Chronicles 24:20** Then **the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest**, who stood above the people, and said to them, “Thus says God: ‘Why do you transgress the commandments of the LORD, so that you cannot prosper? Because you have forsaken the LORD, He also has forsaken you.’”

Who is Holy Spirit

Foretold by Prophets

- **Isaiah 44:3** For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, And floods on the dry ground; I will pour **My Spirit** on your descendants, And My blessing on your offspring;
- **Ezekiel 36:27** I will **put My Spirit** within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.
- **Zechariah 12:10** “And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem **the Spirit of grace** and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.
- **Joel 2:28** “ And it shall come to pass afterward That I will **pour out My Spirit** on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions.

Who is Holy Spirit

While Jesus on earth

- **Luke 1:35** And the angel answered and said to her, “The **Holy Spirit will come upon you**, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.
- **Luke 3:16** John answered, saying to all, “I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose. He will **baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire**.
- Luke 3:22 And the **Holy Spirit descended** in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, “You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased.”
- **Acts 10:38** how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the **Holy Spirit and with power**, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Who is Holy Spirit

Since Jesus left earth

- **John 14:16** And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—
- **John 16:7** Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.
- **Acts 2:4** And they were all **filled with the Holy Spirit** and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- **Revelation 1:10** I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a loud voice, as of a trumpet,
- **Revelation 2:17** "He who has an ear, let him hear **what the Spirit says to the churches**. To him who overcomes I will give some of the hidden manna to eat. And I will give him a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except him who receives it."
- **John 1:33** I did not know Him, but He who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'Upon whom you see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, this is He who **baptizes with the Holy Spirit.**'

Three levels of the Holy Spirit

Spirit of God dwells with us

- **John 14:17** the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He **dwells with you** and will be in you.
- Even before our salvation
- Even when we were sinners
- With every human being living in sin, he prompts and convicts people to receive Christ

Spirit of God lives in us

- **John 14:17** the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and **will be in you**.
- He starts living in us once we receive Him
- At the time of salvation
- His abiding presence, that never take away
- He comes silent

Three levels of the Holy Spirit

Spirit of God comes upon us

- **Acts 1:8** But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has **come upon you**; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”
- He comes upon us to baptize us with Spirit
- He comes upon us for service
- He comes like a rushing wind Acts 2:2
- He comes like a divided tongues Acts 2:3
- He comes like a fire Acts 2:3
- He comes with an initial evidence of speaking in tongues Acts 2:4
- To make us bold to preach the Gospel Acts 4:8, 31 ⁸Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, “Rulers of the people and elders of Israel; ³¹ And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Is Baptism of the Holy Spirit Biblical & has it continued Since Acts 2?

- **Acts 4:8** Then Peter, **filled with the Holy Spirit**, said to them, “Rulers of the people and elders of Israel:
- **Acts 4:31** And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all **filled with the Holy Spirit**, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.
- **Acts 9:17** And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and **be filled with the Holy Spirit.**”
- **Acts 10:44** While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.
- **Acts 13:9 8** But Elymas the sorcerer withstood them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the faith. 9 Then Saul, who also is called Paul, **filled with the Holy Spirit**, looked intently at him 10 and said, “O full of all deceit and all fraud, you son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease perverting the straight ways of the Lord?
- **Acts 13:52** And the disciples were **filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.**
- Peter & John in Samaria **Acts 8:17** Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.
- Paul at Ephesus **Acts 19:6** And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

Is speaking in tongues Biblical?

- **Isaiah 28:11** For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people,
- **Acts 2:4** And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- **Acts 10:44-46** While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word. And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God.
- **1 Corinthians 14:2** For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.
- **1 Corinthians 14:4** He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church.

Is speaking in tongues Biblical?

- **1 Corinthians 14:5** I wish you all spoke with tongues, but even more that you prophesied; for he who prophesies is greater than he who speaks with tongues, unless indeed he interprets, that the church may receive edification.
- **1 Corinthians 14:13** Therefore let him who speaks in a tongue pray that he may interpret.
- **1 Corinthians 14:18** I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all;
- **1 Corinthians 14:22** Therefore tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe but to unbelievers; but prophesying is not for unbelievers but for those who believe.
- **1 Corinthians 14:27** If anyone speaks in a tongue, let there be two or at the most three, each in turn, and let one interpret.
- **1 Corinthians 14:39** Therefore, brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak with tongues.

Five different types of tongues

1. Tongues of Men - **1 Corinthians 13** Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.
2. Tongues of Angels - **1 Corinthians 13** Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.
3. Language of Paradise - **2 Corinthians 12:3-4** And I know such a man whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows how he was caught up into Paradise and heard inexpressible words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter.
4. Language of the Spirit - **Romans 8:26** Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
5. God's language - **Isaiah 28:11-12** (NIV) Very well then, with foreign lips and strange tongues God will speak to this people,

Why do we need the anointing?

- We are sealed - **Ephesians 1:13** In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,
- It is a guarantee - **2 Corinthians 1:21-22** Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.
- Helps & intercedes - **Romans 8:26** Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- Helper - **John 14:16** And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever
- Inner man to get strengthened - **Ephesians 3:16**
- It is a promise of God - **Luke 24:49**
- To be led by spirit - **Romans 8:14**

Why do we need the anointing?

- To walk in the Spirit - **Galatians 5:16** I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.
- To do what Jesus did - **Acts 10:38** how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.
- Anointing upon Jesus - **Isaiah 61:1-31**
- To fight against the enemy - **Isaiah 59:19**
- To receive power - **Acts 1:8**
- Gifts to operate - **1 Corinthians 12:8-11**

How do you receive the anointing?

1. Repent

- **Acts 2:38** Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- **Romans 3:23** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- **1 John 1:8-9** If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- **John 3:3,5** Jesus answered and said to him, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.” Jesus answered, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

How do you receive the anointing?

2. Be baptized

- **Acts 2:38** Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Fulfilling righteousness - **Matthew 3:15**
- Final command - **Matthew 28:19**
- Only who believe is baptized - **Mark 16:16**
- Jesus was baptized - **Matthew 3:16**
- Paul’s immediate step - **Acts 9:17-19**
- Act of obedience - **2 Kings 5:14**
- Buried with Christ - **Romans 6:3-4**
- Wearing Christ - **Galatians 3:26-27**

How do you receive the anointing?

3. Long for

- **Psalm 42:1** As the deer pants for the water brooks, So pants my soul for You, O God.
- **John 7:37-38** On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.”
- **Isaiah 44:3** For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, And floods on the dry ground; I will pour My Spirit on your descendants, And My blessing on your offspring;
- **Isaiah 55:1** “Ho! Everyone who thirsts, Come to the waters; And you who have no money, Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk Without money and without price.
- **2 Kings 4:1-6** Elisha and the Widow’s Oil

How do you receive the anointing?

4. Ask Him

- **Luke 11:11-13** 11 If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if *he asks* for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? 12 Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will *your* heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!”

How do you receive the anointing?

5. Surrender

- **Romans 6:13** And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.
- **Isaiah 6:5-7**“ Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, The LORD of hosts.” Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth with it, and said: “ Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, And your sin purged.”
- **2 Corinthians 10:3-5** casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

How do you receive the anointing?

6. Take a step of faith

- **John 7:38-39** He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.
- **James 1:6-8** But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.
- **Hebrews 11:6** But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
- **Psalms 81:10** I am the LORD your God, Who brought you out of the land of Egypt; Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.
- **Acts 2:4** And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

How do you know that you are anointed?

- Speaking in tongues is the initial evidence of the baptism of the Holy Spirit
- **Acts 2:4** And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- **Acts 10:44-46** While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word. And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God.
- **Other experiences:** Feel like a mighty wind, rushing waters, warmth, electric shock, etc.

What is the next step after receiving the anointing?

- Right fellowship
- Holy living
- Disciplined prayer life
- Meditation on the Word
- Praying in tongues (in personal prayer and in church set up)
- Seeking for the gifts of the Holy Spirit
- Serving the Lord
