# DAY 1: REPENTANCE

- As individuals: repentance for personal sins
- As families: repentance for when we have not put God first
- As a church: repentance for when we have cared more for ourselves than for the lost
- As a district: repentance for when we failed to listen to the heart of God

## 1. Return to God with all our heart

*Joel 2:12-13 "Now, therefore," says the Lord, "Turn to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning." So rend your heart, and not your garments; Return to the Lord your God, For He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness; And He relents from doing harm.*

## 2. Confession

*Proverbs 28:13 You will never succeed in life if you try to hide your sins. Confess them and give them up; then God will show mercy to you.*

*James 5:16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.*

## 3. Unforgiveness

*Matthew 6:14 "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.*

## 4. All kinds of pride

*2 Chronicles 7:14 Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land.*

## 5. Impure conscience

*Hebrew 9:14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!*

## 6. Not loving God

*Revelation 2:4 Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love*  
*1John4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.*

## 7. Fleshly sins

*Galatians 5:19-21 Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.*

## **8. Brokenness**

*Psalm 34:18 The LORD is near to the broken hearted; He saves the contrite in spirit.*

## **9. Worry**

*Matthew 6:34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.*

## **10. Slaves of sin**

*Romans 6:6-7 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin.*

## **11. Lying spirit**

*Psalm 119:29 Remove from me the way of lying, And grant me Your law graciously.  
Proverbs 12:22 Lying lips are an abomination to the Lord, But those who deal truthfully are His delight.*

## **12. Doers, not hearers only**

*James 1:21-22 Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.*

## **13. Faith without work is dead**

*James 2:26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.*

## **14. Our careless words**

*Matthew 12:36-37 But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.*

## **15. Taming the tongue**

*James 3:8 But no man can tame the tongue. It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.*

## **16. Hatred**

*1 John 4:20-21 If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, [a]how can he love God whom he has not seen? And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God must love his brother also.*

## **17. Life distractions**

*Mark 4:19 And the cares of this world, the deceitfulness of riches, and the desires for other things entering in choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful.*

## **18. Judging others**

*Matthew 7:1 "Judge not, that you be not judged.*

**19. Loving the world**

*1 John 2:15-17 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.*

**20. Living in deception**

*James 1:26-27 If anyone among you thinks he is religious and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one's religion is useless. Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world.*

**21. Need of redemption through the blood of Jesus**

*Ephesians 1:7,8 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence.*

**22. Renewal of mind**

*Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.*

**23. Crucified with Christ**

*Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.*

# DAY 2: CHURCH PASTORS & FAMILIES

## 1. Pray for Pastor's Personal Life

### 1. Love God

*Deuteronomy 6:5- Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.*

### 2. Delight in the Word of God

*Psalms 1:2-3 But his delight is in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.*

### 3. Prayer life

*1 Timothy 2:1-4 First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.*

*1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing*

### 4. Qualities

*1 Timothy 3:3-4 This is a faithful saying: If a man desires the position of a bishop, he desires a good work. 2 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, temperate, sober-minded, of good behavior, hospitable, able to teach; not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money, but gentle, not quarrelsome, not covetous; one who rules his own house well, having his children in submission with all reverence.*

### 5. A good servant of Jesus Christ

*Matthew 16:24-26 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it. For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?"*

## **2. Pray for Your Pastor's Family Life**

### **1. Love their wives**

*Ephesians 5: 24, 28-29* Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 28 So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. 29 For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church.

### **2. Understand his wife**

*1 Peter 3:7* -Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

### **3. Character of wife**

*1 Timothy 3:11* Likewise, their wives must be reverent, not slanderers, temperate, faithful in all things.

*Proverbs 31:11,12* The heart of her husband safely trusts her; So he will have no lack of gain. She does him good and not evil. All the days of her life.

*Ephesians 5:22* Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

### **4. Caring his own house**

*1 Timothy 3:12* Let deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well.

*1 Timothy 3:4-5* one who rules his own house well, having his children in submission with all reverence. (for if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the church of God?).

### **5. Train children**

*Proverbs 22:6* -Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.

### **6. Teach children**

*Deuteronomy 11:18-19* "Therefore you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 19 You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.

### **7. Protection**

*Psalm 34:7* The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, and he delivers them.

*Psalm 91:11* For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.

### **8. Discipline children**

*Ephesians 6:4* Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger; instead, bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

## **3. Pray for Your Pastor's Ministry Life**

### **1. Be a good shepherd**

*Isaiah 40:11 He tends His flock like a shepherd; He gathers the lambs in His arms and carries them close to His heart. He gently leads the nursing ewes.*

*Acts 20:28 - Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.*

### **2. Spiritual wisdom**

*1 Corinthians 2:7-9 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for our glory, 8 which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. 9 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man. The things which God has prepared for those who love Him."*

### **3. Walk in unity**

*Philippians 2:2-4 fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.*

### **4. Keys of the kingdom**

*Matthew 16:19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."*

### **5. Gifts of the spirit**

*1 Corinthians 12: 8-10 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.*

### **6. Builds the church**

*Matthew 16:18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.*

### **7. Mind of Christ**

*1 Corinthians 2:16 For "who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ.*

### **8. Fasting and praying**

*Nehemiah 1:4 So it was, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned for many days; I was fasting and praying before the God of heaven.*

### **9. The good news of salvation**

*Isaiah 61:1 "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, Because the Lord has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound.*

# DAY 3: CHURCHES AND MINISTRIES

- Praying for churches
- Praying for evangelism and outreach ministries
- Praying for the spiritual growth of the believers
- Praying for churches to fulfill the purpose of existence
- Praying for churches to prepare themselves as a bride of the coming King

## **1. To give thanks to the Lord**

*Ephesians 5:20 Giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.*

## **2. To know the truth about the power of praise and worship**

*Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.*

*John 4:24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.*

## **3. To be renewed spiritually**

*2 Corinthians 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day.*

## **4. To receive the power of the Holy Spirit**

*Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.*

## **5. To be rooted in the Word of God**

*Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.*

## **6. Pray for the church to pray continuously**

*1 Thessalonians 5:17 pray without ceasing*

*Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak."*

### **7. Pray for the church to reflect God's character**

*2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.*

*Colossians 3:12-14 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.*

### **8. Praying for the love of God**

*1 Corinthians 13:4-6 Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.*

*Romans 12:9,10 Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.*

*10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;*

### **9. Prayer for faith**

*Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.*

### **10. Pray for the church to fight and win spiritual battles**

*2 Corinthians 10: 3-5 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,*

*Mark 3:27 No one can enter a strong man`s house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man. And then he will plunder his house.*

### **11. Pray to being an overcomer**

*1John 4:4 You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.*

*Romans 8:31 What then are we to say about these things? If God is for us, who is against us?*

### **12. Pray for the church to beware of false prophets**

*Jeremiah 23:16 Thus says the Lord of hosts: ``Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you. They make you worthless; They speak a vision of their own heart, Not from the mouth of the Lord.*

### **13. Pray for the church to walk in unity**

*Ephesians 4:2-3 With all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.*

**14. Prayer for the healing**

*Isaiah 53:4-5 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.*

*Psalms 107:20 He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions.*

**15. Prayer for strength**

*2 Samuel 22:33,40 God is my strength and power, And He makes my way perfect. For You have armed me with strength for the battle; You have subdued under me those who rose against me.*

**16. Prayer for protection**

*Proverbs 18:10 The name of the Lord is a strong tower; The righteous run to it and are safe.*

*Psalms 91:1-2 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust. waste at noonday.*

**17. Pray for the church to serve the Lord**

*1 Timothy 4:2 Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.*

**18. Prayer for the church families**

*1 Corinthians 7:2-4 Nevertheless, because of sexual immorality, let each man have his own wife, and let each woman have her own husband. Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband. The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. And likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does.*

*Ephesians 6:1-2 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother, which is the first commandment with promise.*

**19. Pray for the church to seek the kingdom of God**

*1 Corinthians 4:20 For the kingdom of God is not in word but in power. Matthew 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.*

**20. Pray for the church to be ready for the judgement day**

*Matthew 12:36,37 But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."*

*Matthew 16:27 For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.*

# DAY 4: YOUTH & CHILDREN

- Praying for spiritual life and the right environment where they can be nurtured
- Praying against any spiritual attacks that may take hold of their minds
- Praying for witnessing Christ among their friends

## **1. Salvation**

*Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.*

## **2. To love God**

*Deuteronomy 6:5 Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.*

## **3. Choice making**

*Matthew 7:13-14 Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few.*

## **4. Protect their eyes**

*Psalms 119:37 Turn my eyes away from worthless things; preserve my life according to your word.*

## **5. Keep pure**

*Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart, For they shall see God.*

*Proverbs 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart for everything you do flows from it.*

## **6. Friendships**

*Proverb 13:20 Whoever walks with the wise becomes wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm. Proverbs 12:26 "The righteous choose their friends carefully, but the way of the wicked leads them astray."*

## **7. Worship the Lord**

*Psalms 96:9 Oh, worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth.*

**8. Love others**

*Leviticus 19:18 Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against any of your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the LORD.*

**9. Sharing gospel**

*Mark 16:15 And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.*

**10. Put on the armor of God**

*Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.*

**11. Self control**

*Proverb 25:28 "A man without self-control is like a city broken into and left without walls."*

**12. Obedience**

*Ephesians 6:1,2 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother" which is the first commandment with a promise.*

**13. Slow to anger**

*James 1:20 "For the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God."*

**14. Forgive**

*Colossians 3:13 Bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.*

**15. No fear**

*2 Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline.*

**16. Generous heart**

*Mt 6:21 "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."*

**17. Humbleness**

*1 Peter 5:5 Young men, in the same way, submit yourselves to your elders. And all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble."*

**18. Physical health**

*Exodus 15:26 Saying, "If you will diligently listen to the voice of the Lord your God, and do that which is right in his eyes, and give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, your healer."*

**19. Emotional health**

*Psalms 147:3 He heals the broken hearted and binds up their wounds.*

**20. Temptation**

*Matthew 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.'*

**21. Wisdom**

*James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.*

*Proverbs 9:10 "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.*

**22. Trust in God**

*Proverbs 3:5,6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.*

**23. Knowledge of God**

*Psalm 139:13,14 - For You formed my inmost being; You knit me together in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Marvelous are Your works, and I know this very well.*

**24. Love justice**

*Psalm 37:27-29 Turn away from evil and do good; so shall you dwell forever. For the Lord loves justice; he will not forsake his saints. They are preserved forever, but the children of the wicked shall be cut off. The righteous shall inherit the land and dwell upon it forever.*

**25. Love God's Word**

*Psalm 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night.*

**26. Learn how to pray**

*Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.*

**27. Seeking heavenly things**

*Colossians 3:1-2 If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.*

**28. Future**

*Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.*

**29. Safety**

*Proverbs 18:10 "The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe. Psalm 91, Psalm 121*

## 1. District staff - Pray for their personal life, family and work

### 1. Love God and others
